



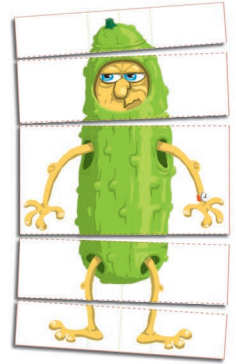

MAKE IT YOURSELF!

Howdy!

You've played **Slide-a-ma-jig** on your iPhone... now it's time to **MAKE IT YOURSELF!** Just follow these simple instructions:

Print out your own **SCAT** (*Slide-a-ma-jig Character Alignment Template*) found as the second page of this document. The **SCAT** has been manufactured in a reduced color scheme to allow minimum printer ink usage impact.

Use the horizontal **RED DASHED** lines to divide your characters into the 5 basic **Slide-a-ma-jig** parts:

1. Hat, hair, lid, chapeau, crown...
2. Head, face, mask, noggin, kisser...
3. Body, torso, trunk, chassis, belly...
4. Legs, stilts, stems, tentacles, gams...
5. Feet, hooves, paws, flippers, tootsies...

Use the verticle **GREEN DASHED** lines to help align your character parts so they match up after cutting. The most critical alignment points are the **BETWIXT** line and the **BIG GREEN DOT** areas where the legs and feet parts connect. Skinny, fat, or wiggly, your character's legs should center on those **DOTS** to keep them connected.

When you are done drawing your character, cut out the **RED OUTLINED** box and then cut across the **RED DASHED** lines. Don't cut the **GREEN DASHED** lines or you'll end up with a real mess!

And our final and most important instruction: USE YOUR GOOFY IMAGINATIONS AND HAVE FUN!
